Candidates for office who wish their names to appear on the election ballot must be qualified electors, residing within their respective Municipality, and file a Statement of Candidacy at the Denmark City Hall, 64 City Hall St, Denmark, SC 29042. The filing fee is \$50.00 for offices in this election. The filing period begins at noon on Friday, November 29, 2024 and closes at noon on Friday, December 13, 2024. The hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The early voting period for this election begins on Monday, January 27, 2025 and ends on Friday, February 7, 2025. The following early voting center will be open during the early voting period from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (closed Saturday and Sunday).

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs when voting in person.

- S.C. Driver's License
 - Includes standard License and REAL ID
- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card
 - o Includes standard ID card and REAL ID
 - o Includes SC Concealed Weapons Permit
- S.C Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
 - o Includes all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport
 - o Includes US Passport ID Card

Voters who are blind, physically handicapped, or unable to read or write are entitled to assistance in casting their ballot. This assistance may be provided by anyone the voter chooses except his employer, an agent of his employer, or an officer or agent of his union. The managers must be notified if assistance is needed.

Voters who are unable to enter their polling place due to physical handicap or age may vote in the vehicle which they drove, or were driven in, to the polls. When notified, the Managers will help voters using this curbside voting provision.

Registered voters who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the Board of Elections and Voter Registration of Bamberg County. You may call 803-245-3028 to inquire about the availability of absentee ballots.

At 6:30 p.m. on Election Day, the County Election Commission will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at the J. Carl Kearse Agricultural Building, 847 Calhoun St., Bamberg, SC 29003, 803-245-3028.
